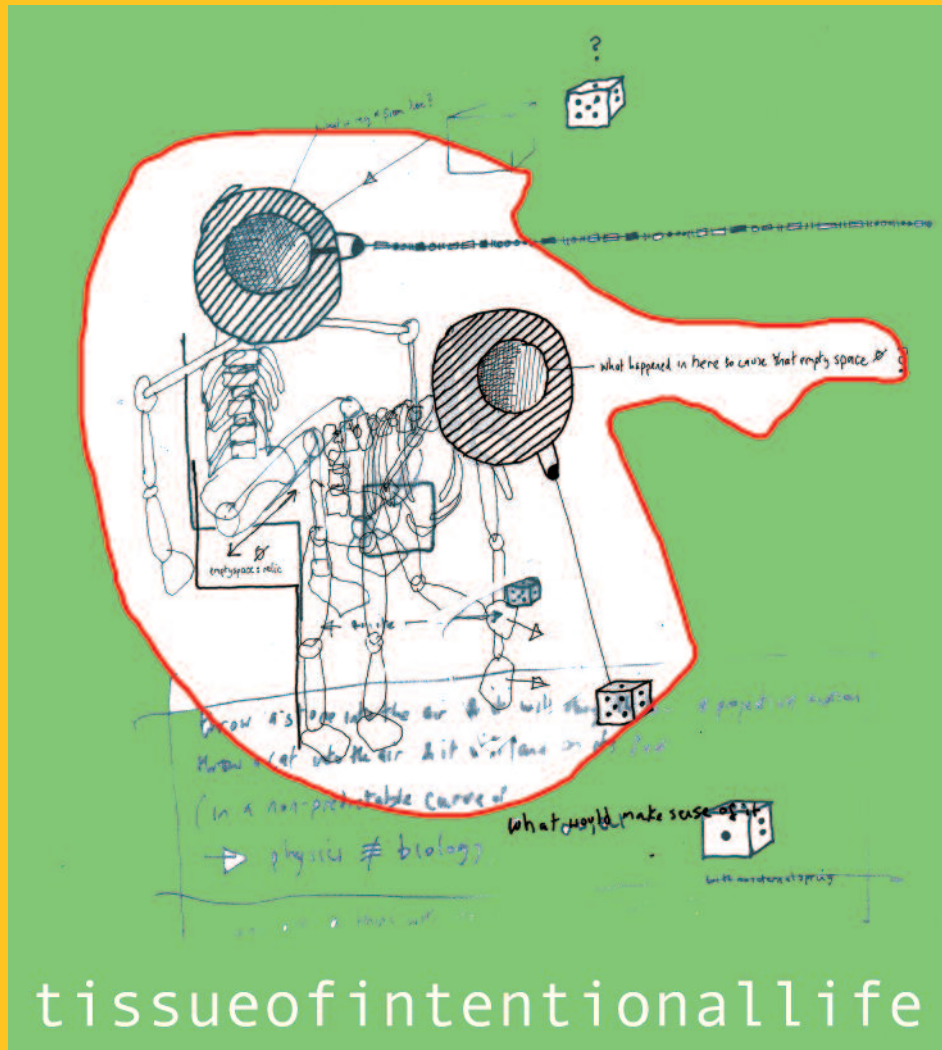


PHENOMENOLOGY AND PSYCHIATRY FOR THE 21ST CENTURY
